Re: HIV PEP medications coverage under the Manitoba HIV Medications Program

The process for public funding of HIV post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) medications has changed.

The full 28-day course of HIV PEP has been covered for all Manitobans since 2021. Beginning June 3, 2024, anyone with an active Manitoba Health Registration Number who does not have 100% prescription medication coverage under another federal or provincial program is eligible for coverage under the Manitoba HIV Medications Program (MHMP).
